Tips to handle the EXTREME COLD WEATHER

- Keep you Air Filters Clean
- Keep your heat a few degrees higher than you usually do. We recommend having it at 70 degrees when the temperature is extremely low.
- Turn OFF all automatic settings that lower your heat at certain times of the day. Be sure to leave the heat consistently running for the duration of the extreme weather.
- Keep vents clear. Check outside pipes to make sure they are clear of ice.
- Be aware that it will take your system more time to warm up indoor areas, be prepared and plan ahead.
- Keep exterior door and windows closed as much as possible. Remember to shut garage overhead doors, breezeway doors, basement and attic doors, which may let cold air in.
- Periodically run your water to avoid pipes freezing.
- Be aware of friends, family and neighbors who may have older homes that may more difficultly holding the heat.
